PARK CITY TRANSIT

Welcome to the Park City/Summit County FREE bus system. From 5:43 am until 2:10 am daily, our buses will take you just about anywhere you want to go. The buses serve three world-class ski areas, Park City's Historic District, lodging, shopping, dining and neighborhoods within Park City as well as the Kimball Junction area. Weather and traffic can be severe and parking is limited, so we encourage you to save time, energy and money by riding the bus!

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

- Locate your trip destination on the map.
 One side shows routes/destinations within Park City. The reverse side shows routes/ destinations in Summit County/Kimball Junction.
- Locate your trip origin. (Not every destination and location can be listed in this guide, but you should be able to locate one nearby.)
- Routes servicing select destinations are indicated by color in this guide.
- Identify the nearest route(s) servicing your trip destination. If a transfer is required, major transfer points are Park City Mountain Resort and Old Town Transit Center.
- Service frequency is indicated on the map. Scheduled departure times for each route are posted at each bus stop.
- For specific stop times, please refer to the Transit Time Point Guide which is designed to be used in conjunction with the Transit System Guide. Both guides are available on all Transit buses as well as in the Old Town Transit Center. You may also log on to www.parkcity.org.

BUS STOPS

For passenger safety, drivers are instructed to pick up and drop off passengers at designated bus stops



only. Bus stops are easy to find. Just look for the blue signs with white lettering. Routes servicing a stop and departure times will also be posted at each stop. Locations of all bus stops and transfer points are indicated

on the route maps. Please plan to arrive at the bus stop a few minutes before the scheduled departure time. As the bus approaches, please check the destination display on the front of the bus to ensure you are boarding the correct bus.

WHILE ON THE BUS

We welcome you aboard. If all seats are full, please move away from the doors to allow others to board. Seats near the front of the bus should be offered to the elderly and riders with disabilities. For the safety and comfort of all passengers, please refrain from playing radios or CDs without earphones while on the bus. Smoking, eating, drinking, and animals (except service animals) are not allowed.



MAIN STREET TROLLEY SERVICE

The Trolley operates from 10:00 am to 11:00 pm daily, and will stop just about anywhere along Main Street. Stand at any of the Trolley stop signs or give a wave to the driver indicating you would like a ride. The Trolley also serves as a connection to the Old Town Transit Center where transfers can be made to all other routes in the system.

DIAL-A-RIDE H

Service is available to the Park City Ice Arena and Sports Complex, National Ability Center, Park City Medical Center, Summit County Public Health Center and People's Health Clinic. For more information, please call 435-640-7819 between 8:00 am and 9:00 pm. Dial-A-Ride guides are available on all Park City Transit buses.


EARLY MORNING AND LATE NIGHT BUS SERVICE

PARK CITY MOBILITY

All Park City/Summit County transit buses are ADA accessible and drivers are trained to assist those with disabilities. A Door-to-Door Paratransit service is also provided for passengers that are unable to use the fixed route service. For further information and an ADA Eligibility Application, contact our Paratransit Certification Office, Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, 435-615-5353, TTY 435-615-7041.

SAFE HAVEN PROGRAM

If you feel that you are in imminent danger, just board a Park City Transit bus. Drivers are in direct contact with the police department.

HWY 224 EXPRESS SERVICE

An Express Bus travels directly between Park City's Old Town Transit Center (OTTC) and Kimball Junction in 15 minutes. The Express departs the OTTC on the hour. The first Express bus departs at 7:00 am, the last Express bus departs at 9:00 pm.

The Express bus also departs from Kimball Junction at Newpark for Park City's Historic Main Street (:45) minutes after the hour, from 7:45 am until 9:45 pm.
